

Kent Treble Bob



Method Focus – Kent Treble Bob

Learning a method by the blue line and place-bells will work for every method, but there are some methods where there is another way. Methods such as "Plain Bob", "Little Bob", "Kent Treble Bob" and "Oxford Treble Bob" can be learnt by a set of rules instead. This makes them easier to learn, but in the long run it is still useful to review the blue-line to get an overview of the structure of the method. Lets have a look at Kent Treble Bob:

The Rules - Plain Course

The Treble

• Treble Bob Hunting (i.e. dodge in 1/2, 3/4, 5/6, 7/8, both up and down) starting with a dodge in 1/2

All Other Bells

- If you dodge in 1/2 down with the treble at the front, then keep leading and making seconds until the treble comes back down, then dodge with the treble in 1/2 up and go out.
- Treble bob hunt everywhere EXCEPT ...
- Don't dodge at the front (in 1/2) unless its with the treble
- If the treble is below you when you are in 3/4 then make places instead of dodging.
 - make 4ths then 3rds instead of 3/4 down
 - make 3rds then 4ths instead of 3/4 up.

The Rules - Bobs and Singles

Bob


- If you are doing 3/4 down places when the **bob** is called you are unaffected
- If you are doing 3/4 up places when the **bob** is called, make 3rds, then 4 blows in 4ths, then make 3rds and go in
- If you are dodging with the treble when the **bob** is called, then you are unaffected
- If you have just finished doing 3/4 down places when the **bob** is called, you are unaffected
- If you were doing a 5/6 (or above) dodge when the **bob** is called, do an extra dodge for the bob, and then continue on to another dodge in the same place. i.e. do a total of 3 dodges wherever you are instead of 1

Single

- If you are doing 3/4 down places when the **single** is called you make 4ths, then 4 blows in 3rds then 4ths and go out
- If you are dodging with the treble when the **single** is called, make seconds over the treble and dodge with the treble in 1/2 down.
- All other bells are as per a bob
